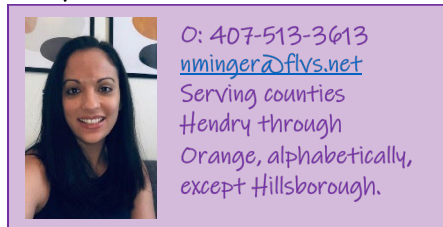

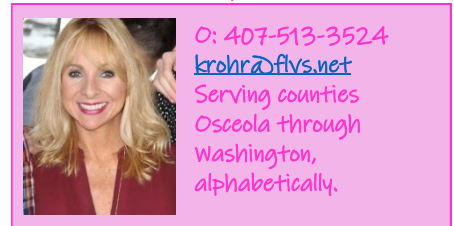

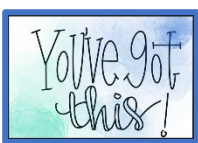

- Be sure to withdraw your child from his or her public school and choose "Home Education" as the physical school in his/her academic profile.
- Next, you will need to register your child with your district Home Education Office by sending a Letter of Intent. Most districts have a pre-made form that can be found on their website.

IMPORTANT MESSAGE ABOUT PROOF OF RESIDENCY:

All students will need a POR added for each fiscal year, which began on July 1st. You will continue to see a message requesting a POR until your uploaded document has been verified by our team.
